

Eltis to start 5-day training session for teachers

Pune: A five-day Content and Language Integrated Learning @ India (CLIL@India) training programme will start on August 6 at the English Language Teaching Institute of Symbiosis (Eltis).

Eltis, a department of Symbiosis International University (SIU), has announced that the international project aims at promoting a new teaching methodology among schoolteachers. It aims to boost teachers' abilities in content training to ensure language enhancement for students.

Vaishali Jundre, deputy director of Eltis, said, "SIU is a partner university of this international project, which focuses on building the capacity of in-service teachers. Any schoolteacher can be a part of this project. This methodology will enhance teaching content for the student with an extra focus on a target language.
